Linen & Bedding Kit	AU\$35 per person, per rental Includes a pillow, pillow case, sleeping bag, sheet and towel
Picnic Table	AU\$22 per rental Kick back in the great outdoors and hire an outdoor table and chairs to relax outside your campervan.
Picnic Chair	AU\$12 per rental Remember, small camping stools are supplied with the Adventurer 4WD and Rookie.
Baby Seat	AU\$25 per rental Can be fitted to the Voyager, Explorer, Frontier and Adventurer 4WD Campervans
Booster Seat	AU\$25 per rental For little ones between the ages of 3 and 8, we have Booster Seats available. You can fit one to any Britz Campervan
Tent (4 persons)	AU\$75 per rental Easy to assemble, four-person waterproof, one piece tent.
Awnings	AU\$5 per day with a maximum charge of \$100 per hire Can be fitted to all Britz Campervans except the Adventurer 4WD which has its own awning. Great for relaxing out the front of your campervan.
First Aid Kit	AU\$30 for purchase In vehicle. If seal is broken customer is charged
Fan Heater	AU\$11.00 per rental This 24V electric fan heater is handy for the HiTop, Voyager and Bushcamper 4WD, which do not feature heating in the living area.
Satellite Phone	AU\$17 per day plus call costs Many areas of Australia do not have standard mobile phone coverage. Satellite phones offer coverage in all areas and are an important safety item for remote travel.
Personal Safe	AU\$20.00 per rental Available with selected vehicles, the safe will give you peace of mind and increase the security of your personal belongings.
Outback Safety Kit	AU\$95.00 per rental This handy kit contains: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Emergency Position Indicating Beacon (EPIRB) – when activated the beacon transmits an emergency distress signal, which can be detected by Australian rescue authorities.• Snatch Strap – used to pull a vehicle from a bogged position (with the aid of another vehicle), in conjunction with the D-Shackles• Bow Shackles – secure the snatch strap to a rigid anchor point• Outback folding spade
